FY 2022 Letter of Intent

Some may not be familiar with Letters of Intent, so here are some questions you may have:

What is a Letter of Intent?

A Letter of Intent is a form for organizations to complete and inform the Collaborative Applicant of the intention to apply for NOFO funding for the coming season.

What is the purpose of a Letter of Intent?

The purpose is to assist the CoC in determining which agencies intend to apply for funding in the upcoming CoC NOFO competition. It can also serve as a checklist for agencies to ensure they have all the information/COC requirements in order to apply.

Do we get the funding for completing it?

Submission of a Letter of Intent is for informational purposes only, it does not ensure that the organization will get NOFO funding. However, the Letter of Intent helps the Collaborative Applicant in the process of applying for funding. Easier for us = Better for you = Better for the CoC!

Who completes the Letter of Intent?

Your organization's primary contact with the CoC can complete this! Your secondary contact can as well! Once completed, please send to collaborativeapplicant@moboscoc.org

Oh, no! We are missing some of the items, do we not get the funding?

That is the beauty of the Letter of Intent! If you notice that your organization needs to complete requirements or gather information, you have plenty of time before NOFO to do that. You do not need all information to submit a Letter of Intent. The Collaborative Applicant team will be here to support as NOFO submission draws near!
