



Supplemental NOFO Eligible Project Types

- ❖ **PH-PSH: Permanent Supportive Housing-** An intensive, best practice intervention for addressing homelessness that combines permanent, subsidized housing with voluntary, wraparound supportive services for populations with disabilities and the most significant needs.
- ❖ **PH-RRH: Rapid Re-Housing-**A program designed to help individuals and families exit homelessness as quickly as possible, move to permanent housing, and achieve stability in that housing.
- ❖ **Joint TH and PH-RRH: Rapid Re-Housing-** a project type that includes two existing program components —TH and RRH—in a single project to serve individuals and families experiencing homelessness.
- ❖ **SSO-CE: Coordinated Entry-** Project geared toward providing interviews and access to the MO BoS CoC Coordinated Entry System.
- ❖ **SSO-non CE: Street Outreach or SSO Other-** Project that works to provide outreach to otherwise unreachable clients and provides or connects them with supportive services.
- ❖ **HMIS: Homeless Management Information Systems-** Only for HMIS lead of MO BoS CoC
