All Continuum of Care (CoC) Program project applications must be reviewed and either accepted and ranked or rejected by the CoC. All project applications approved by the CoC must be listed on the CoC Priority Listing in rank order. Project Ranking beneath each category will follow the scoring criteria set by the applicable project ScoreCards.

Supplemental NOFO: Ranking and Prioritization Policy

Ranking

MO BoS CoC project applications will be ranked in order of score within the project categories listed below. Projects applications serving priorities established by the MO BoS CoC will be ranked at the top of their category regardless of score. Project applications in the same category and serving the same priorities will be ranked against each other by score. Project applications must meet any threshold criteria or other requirements established in the Continuum of Care Supplemental to Address Unsheltered and Rural Homelessness Notice of Funding Availability or by the MO BoS CoC to be ranked. The available will be eligible for competition under two different priority lists following the ranking priorities indicated below.

UNSHELTERED SET ASIDE RANKING

1. CoC wide Project – HMIS
2. CoC wide Project – CES SSO*
3. New Projects submitted by agencies

RURAL SET ASIDE RANKING

1. CoC wide Project – HMIS
2. CoC wide Project – CES SSO*
3. New Projects submitted by agencies

**Project submission will be supplied by the Collaborative Applicant but final distribution of funds will be available through a published RFP process.*

Tiebreaker

If two or more projects in the same project category receive the same score, the projects will be ranked in order of the severity of community housing and supportive service needs and the degree to which the project's plans addresses the identified housing and supportive service needs as assessed by the MO BoS CoC entity responsible for reviewing and ranking project applications. The assessment of severity of community housing and supportive service needs and the project's plan to address the needs will be based on the narrative in the project application. Projects with plans to address more severe needs will receive preferential ranking compared to the other projects receiving the same score.
