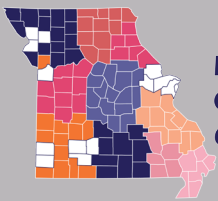

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## HUD DEFINES SHELTERED HOMELESS PERSONS AS

adults, children, and unaccompanied children who, on the night of the count, are living in shelters for the homeless.

...HUD considers individuals and families sleeping in a place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation (e.g., abandoned buildings, train stations, or camping grounds) as unsheltered homeless.

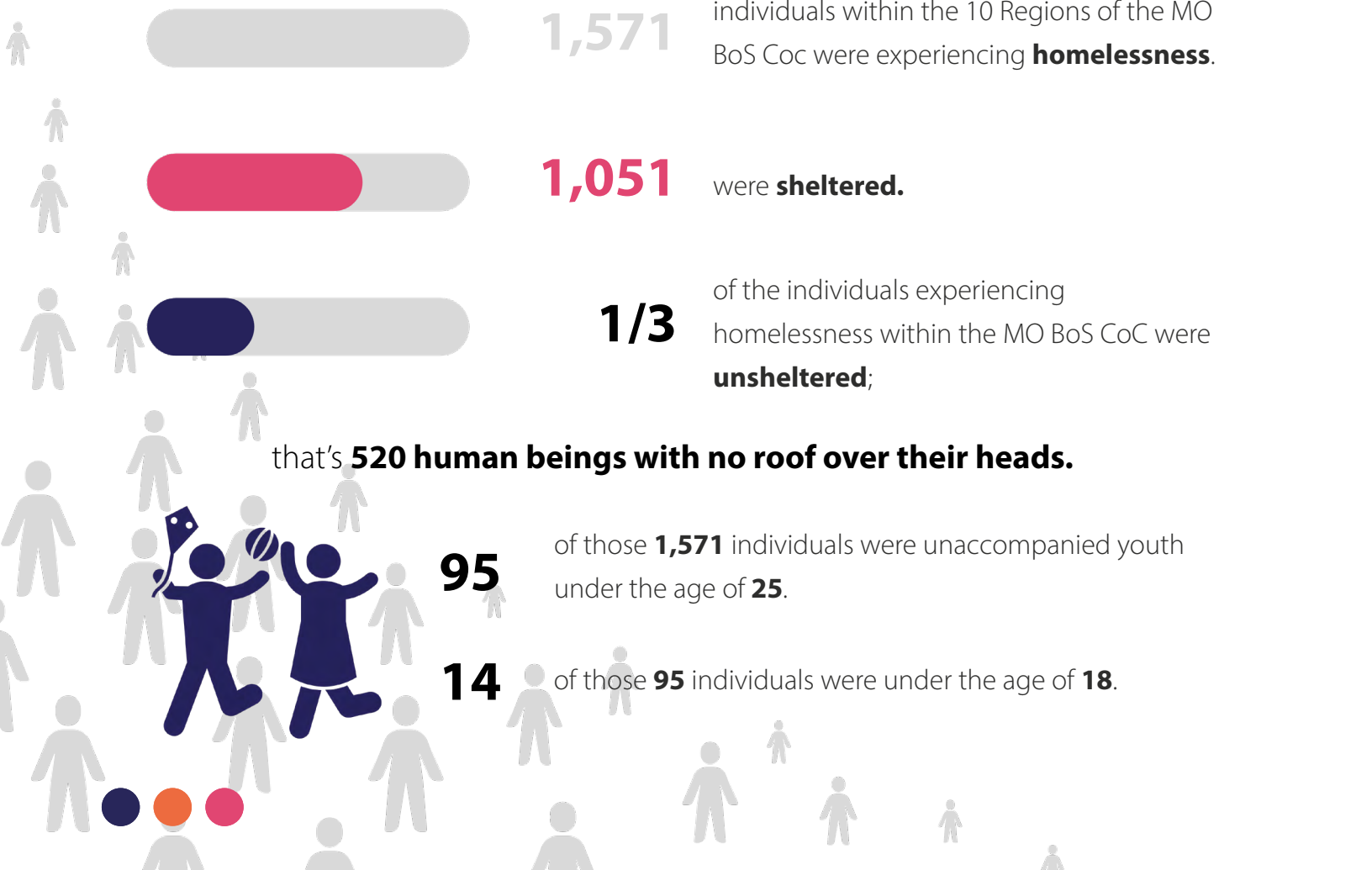

## HUD DEFINES...

... **Emergency Shelter (ES)** as any facility with a primary purpose of providing a temporary shelter for individuals experiencing homelessness.

... **Safe Haven (SH)** as a form of supportive housing that serves hard-to-reach homeless individuals with severe mental illness who come primarily from the streets and have been unable or unwilling to participate in housing or supportive services.

... **Transitional Housing (TH)** as being designed to provide homeless individuals and families with stability and support to successfully move to and maintain permanent housing.

**Chronic Homelessness** describes individuals who experience repeated bouts of homelessness while simultaneously struggling with a disabling condition such as a serious mental illness, substance use disorder, or physical disability.

**906** individuals were in Emergency Shelters - that's **58%** of the MO BoS CoC

**134** individuals were in Transitional Housing .

**8** individuals were in Safe Havens.



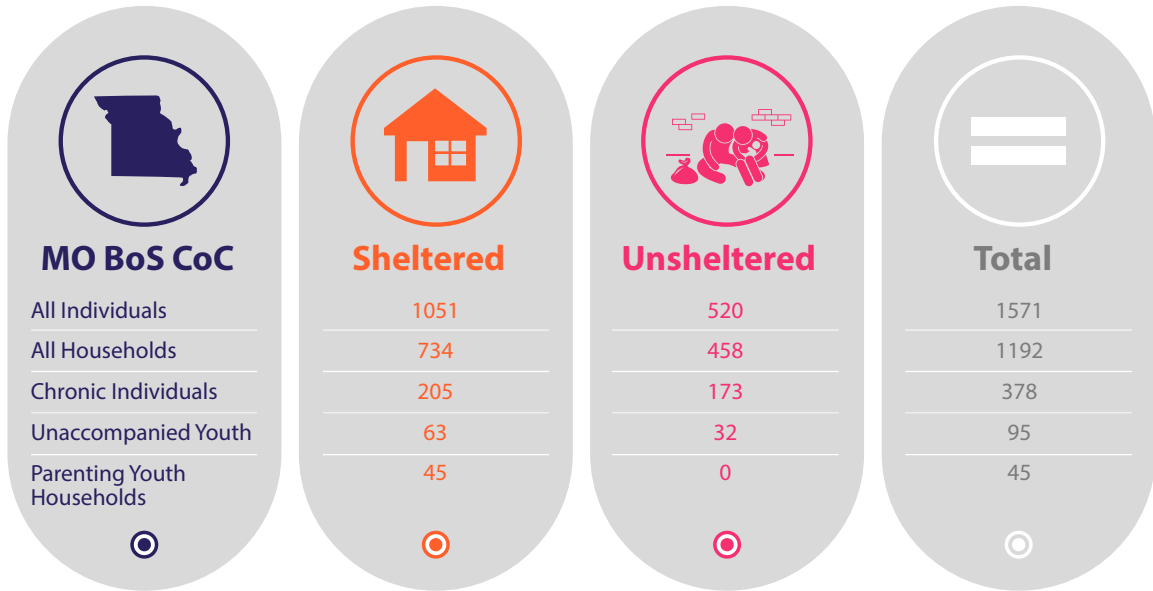
**25%** of individuals surveyed were experiencing **chronic homelessness**.



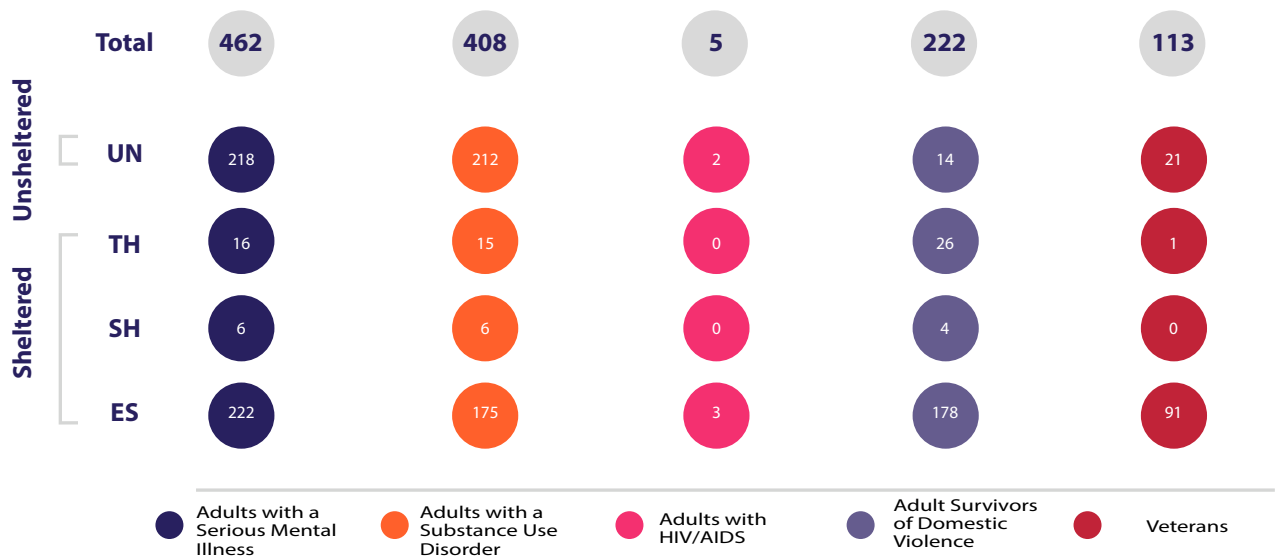
Those who were surveyed represent **40%** of individuals experiencing **homelessness** within in the state of Missouri.

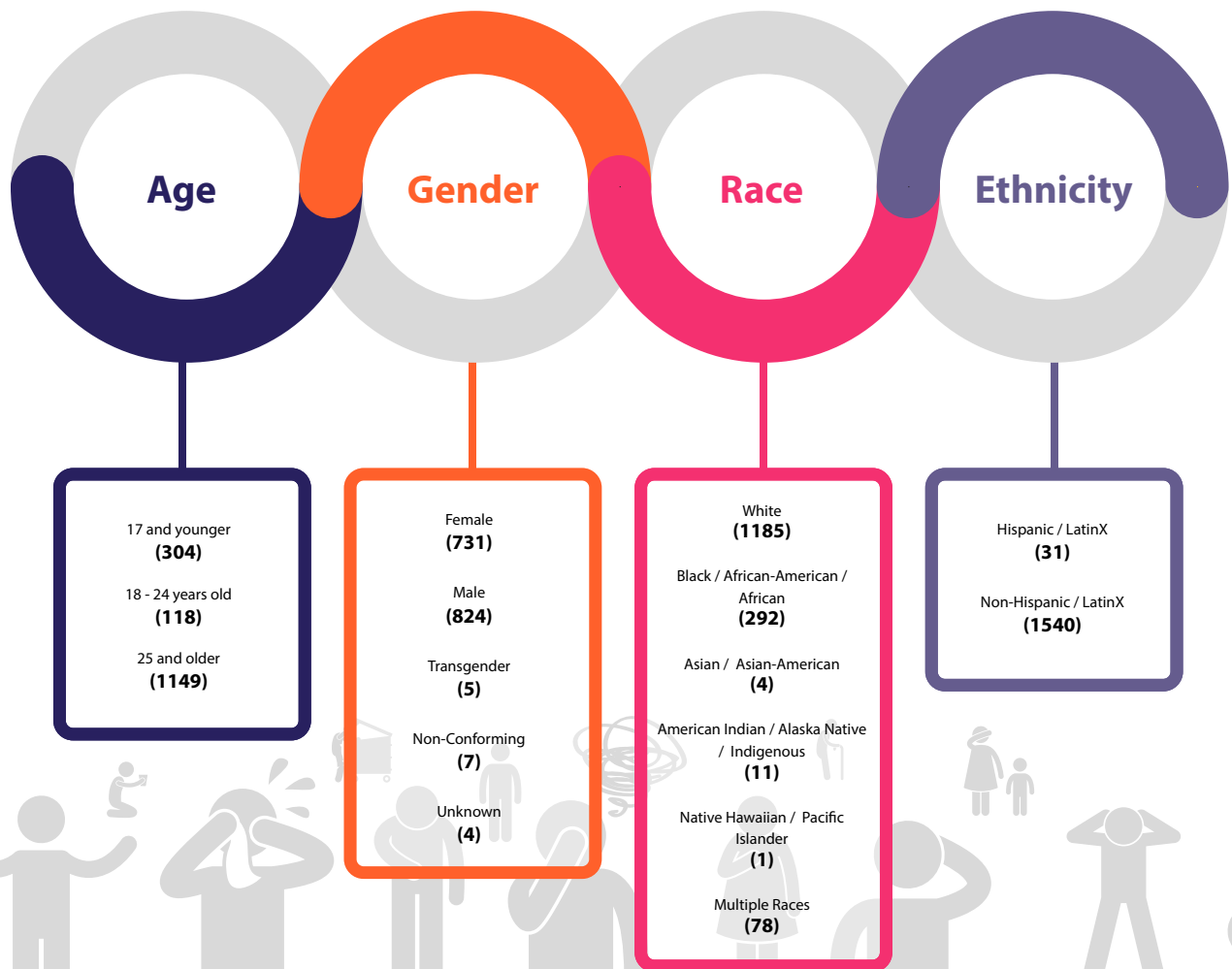

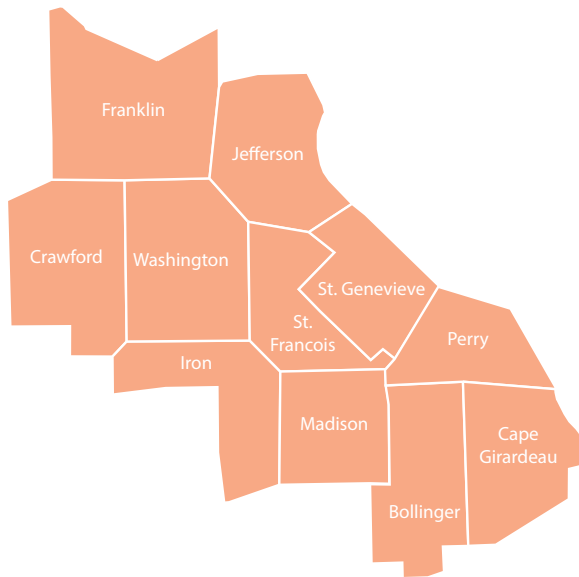


# MO BOS COC DEMOGRAPHIC OVERVIEW

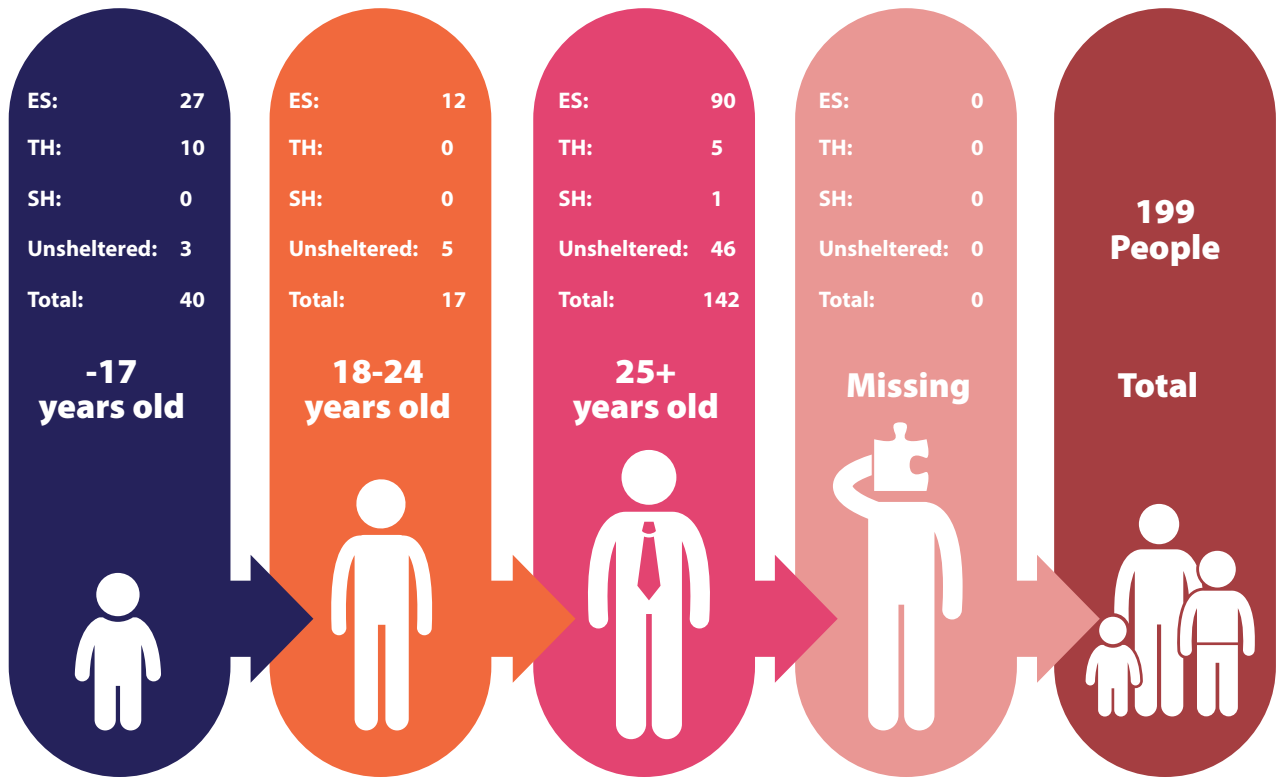

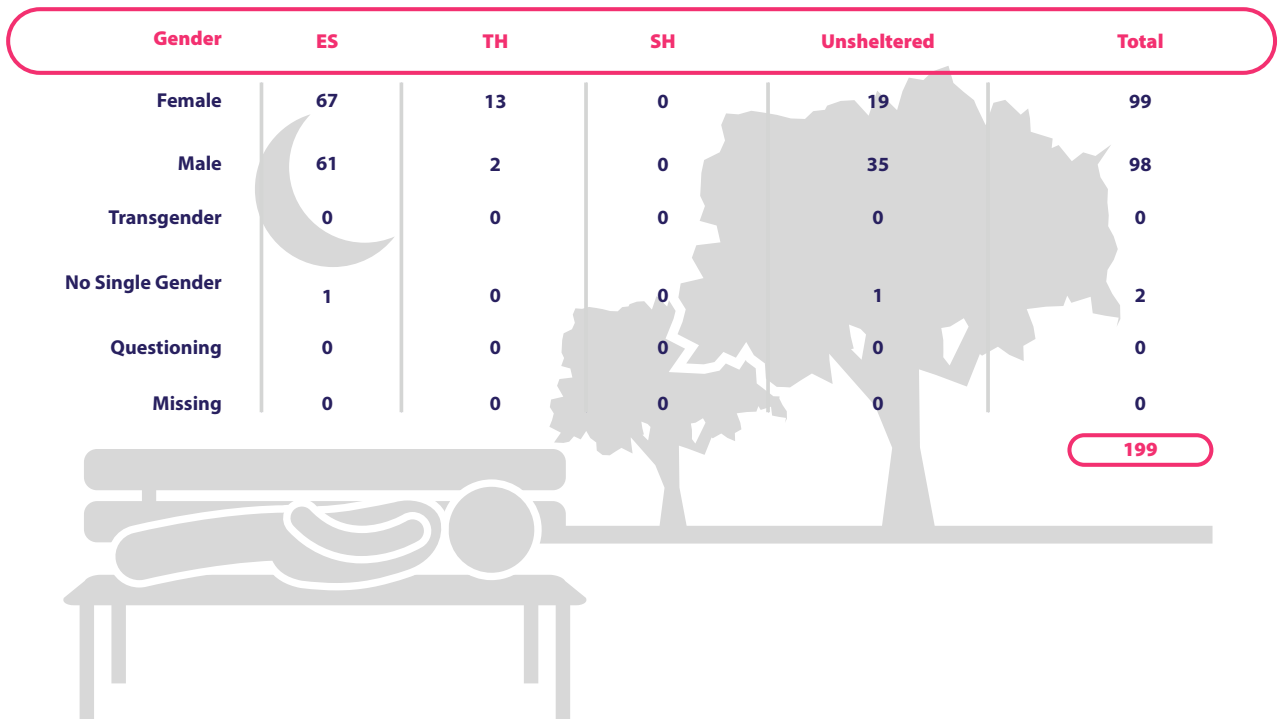




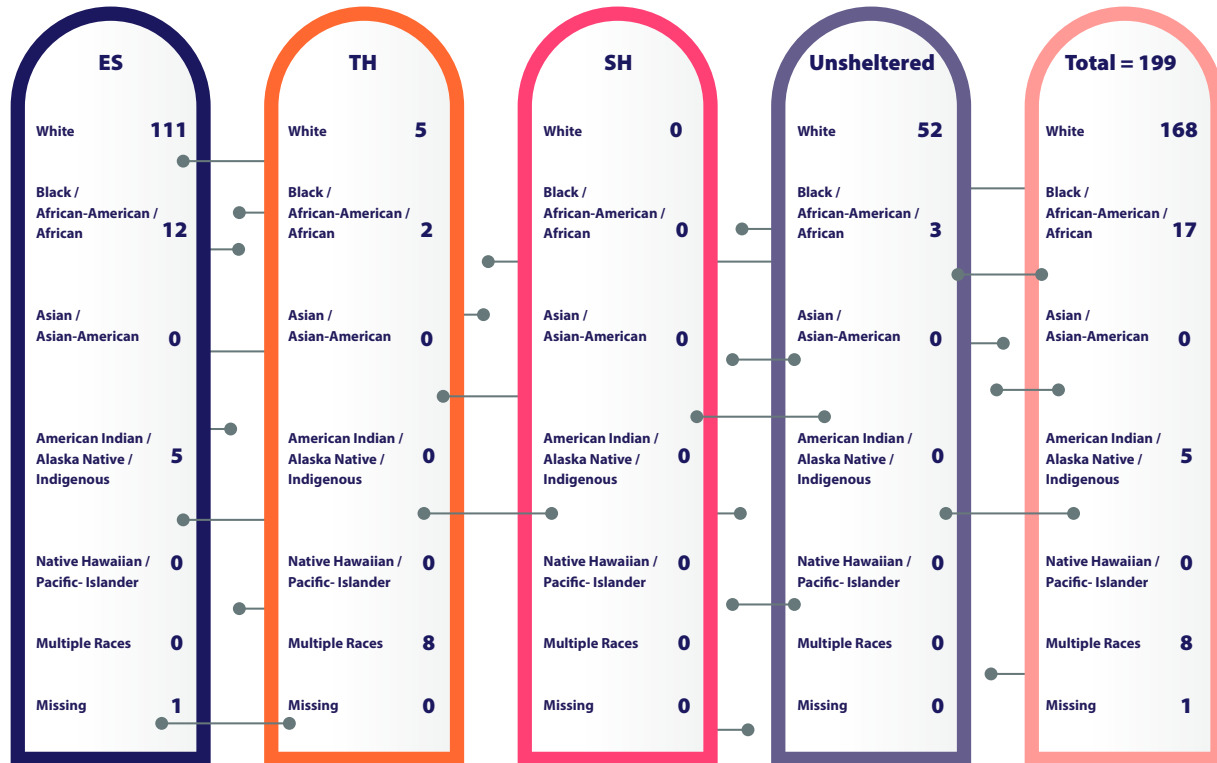
### REGION 1 DEMOGRAPHICS BY AGE



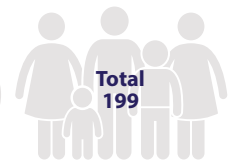
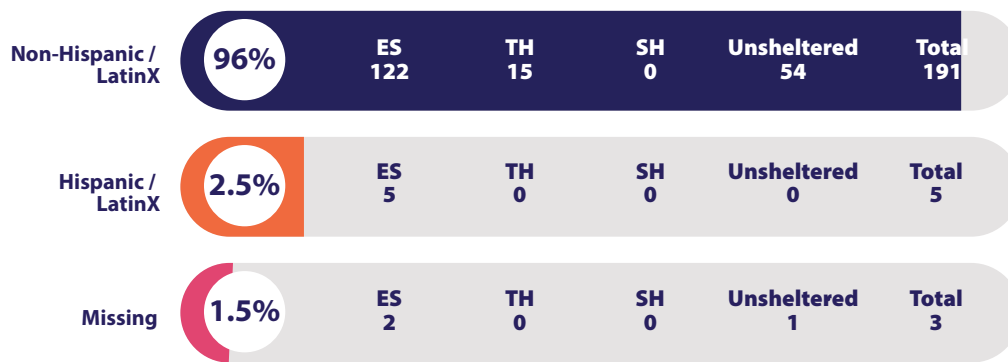
### REGION 1 DEMOGRAPHICS BY GENDER



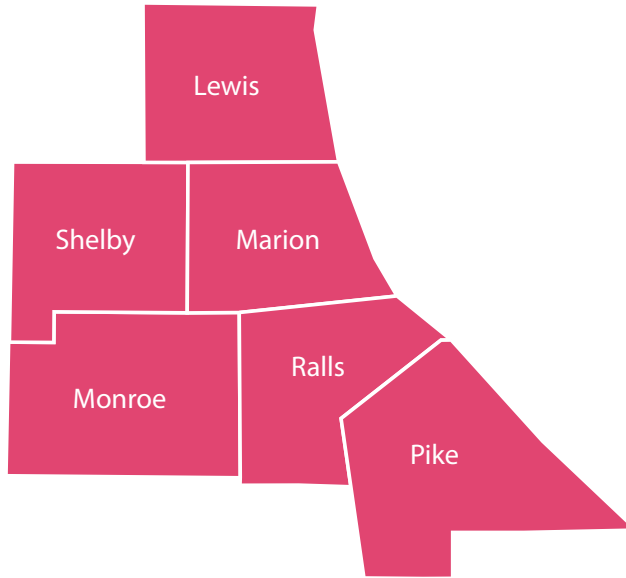

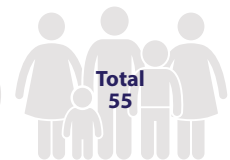
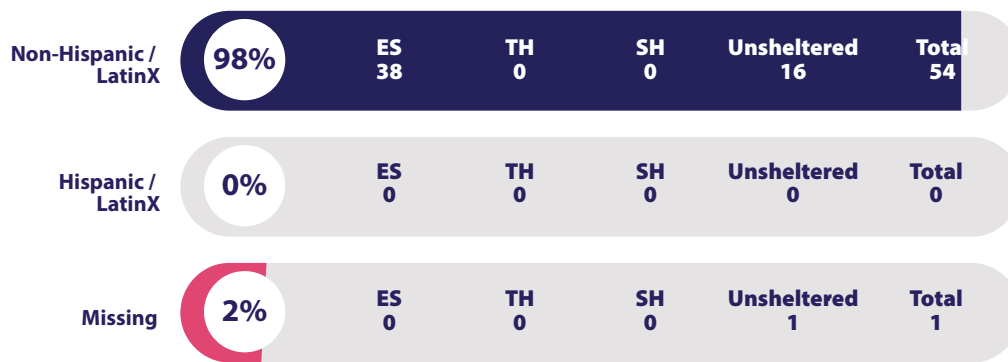
### REGION 2 DEMOGRAPHICS BY GENDER



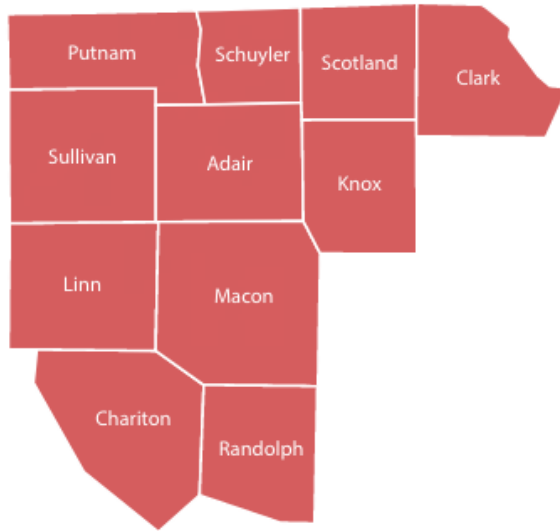

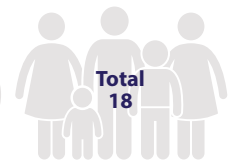
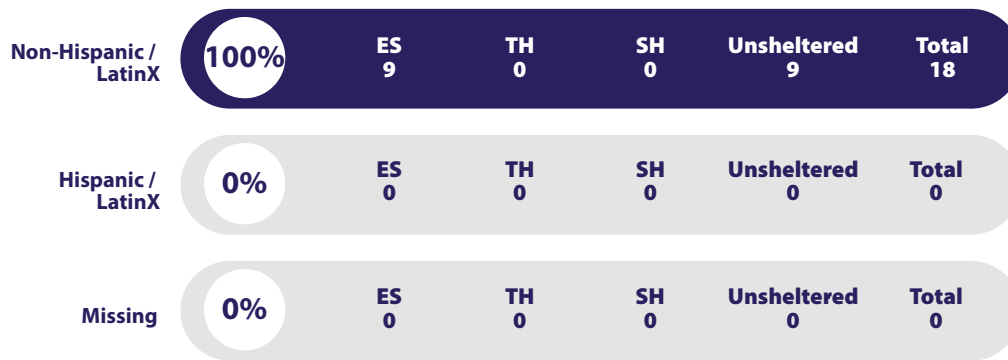
### REGION 3 DEMOGRAPHICS BY GENDER

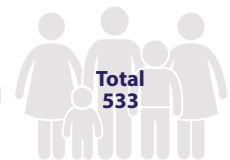
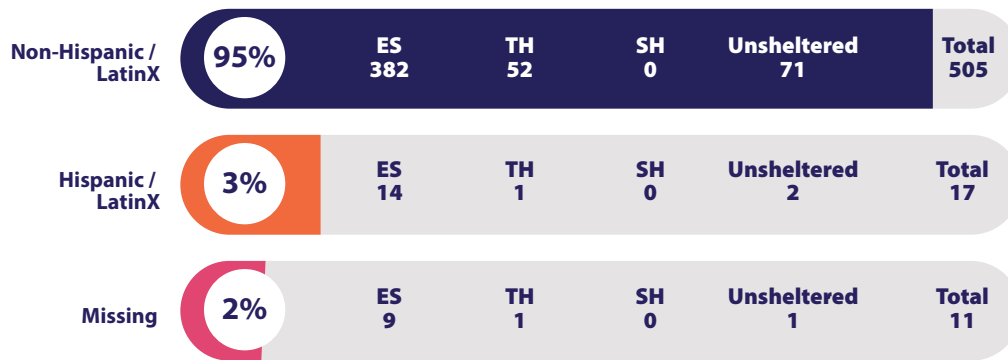
### REGION 5 DEMOGRAPHICS BY GENDER



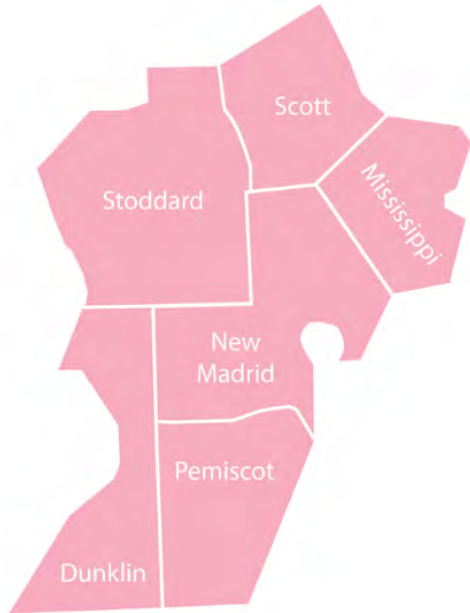
