

About YHDP

The Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP) is a program focused on helping youth (ages 16 to 24) experiencing housing issues. In November 2022, the Missouri Balance of State was awarded \$6.8 million by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to create and carry out a community plan to help solve youth homelessness.

The Coordinated Community Plan (CCP) focuses on the needs of young people, housing, and support services that will be funded by the YHDP to address youth housing issues. Our team is looking for young people with lived experience of housing issues, service providers, and supporters to inform our community plan. We want to know what support young people need, the issues that youth face, and the resources to get safe and stable housing.
