Leah identified that CoC may need or want to make a policy on this. The Performance Committee recommends that the Board adopts the following policy: The CoC encourages all projects to collect a full SSN in HMIS. Factors to consider: DMH uses full SSN in matching between systems, other agencies voiced similar need. Other funding sources (like SSVF) do still require a full SSN. Clients still have the "Refused to answer" option available to them.
