What are the System Performance Measures?

- A series of 7 measures designed to assess system-wide performance
- HUD uses SPMs to compare CoC performance year-to-year not compare CoCs to other CoCs
- ☑ Data pulled from HMIS reports
- Have the option to resubmit last year's data
 - If resubmit, resubmit all measures
 - Can't resubmit only some measures

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Why do the SPMs Matter?





HUD bases funding decisions for the CoC in part on the data submitted

SPM data helps inform local and national planning efforts








HUD System Performance Measures Measure 3: Number of Persons Experiencing Homelessness



HUD System Performance Measures Measure 4: Income Growth for Homeless Persons in CoC-funded Projects



From HDX: This measure is divided into six tables capturing employment and non-employment income changes for system leavers and stayers. The project types reported in these metrics are the same for each metric, but the type of income and universe of clients differs. In addition, the projects reported within these tables are limited to CoC-funded projects.

HUD System Performance Measures Measure 5: *Number of Persons Experiencing Homelessness for the First Time*



From HDX: This measures the number of people entering the homeless system through ES, SH, or TH (Metric 5.1) or ES, SH, TH, or PH (Metric 5.2) and determines whether they have any prior enrollments in the HMIS over the past two years. Those with no prior enrollments are considered to be experiencing homelessness for the first time.



HUD System Performance Measures Measure 7: Successful Exits from Street Outreach and Successful Exits from or Retention of Permanent Housing



From HDX: This measures positive movement out of the homeless system and is divided into three tables: movement off the streets from Street Outreach (Metric 7a.1); movement into permanent housing situations from ES, SH, TH, and RRH (Metric 7b.1); and retention or exits to permanent housing situations from PH (other than PH-RRH).
