FY2026 CoC Program: Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has officially released the FY2026 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program and Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) under opportunity number CPD-2600-DC-0025, posted at the HUD Continuum of Care Program Competition page available at:

The CoC Program is designed to promote a community-wide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness and provide funding to quickly rehouse individuals and families experiencing homelessness, persons experiencing trauma or a lack of safety related to, or fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking, and youth experiencing homelessness while minimizing the trauma and dislocation caused by homelessness. The CoC programs are designed to promote access to mainstream programs and programs funded with State or local resources and optimize self-sufficiency among individuals and families experiencing homelessness. The goal of the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP) is to support the development and implementation of a coordinated community approach to preventing and ending youth homelessness and sharing that experience with and mobilizing communities around the country toward the same end.

The Missouri Balance of State Continuum of Care (MO BoS CoC) is charged by HUD to submit a Consolidated Application, including a project Priority Listing, on behalf of applicant organizations applying for project funding.

This notice launches the Missouri Balance of State Continuum of Care (MO BoS CoC) local funding competition to support projects that advance our shared mission of preventing and ending homelessness in our community.

At this time, HUD has not published additional competition information, applicant instructions or released the estimated funding available to MO BoS CoC for the FY 2026 competition. The Annual Renewal Demand (ARD), including any Bonus funding, will be made available as soon as amounts are published by HUD. Please check HUD's CoC Program Competition page regularly for updates and important information related to the CoC NOFO.

Key Competition Deadlines:

- Local application package due: **July 16, 2026** by or before 5:00 pm CDT (date subject to change based on *e-snaps* opening by HUD).

- MO BoS Consolidated Application, including the Priority Listing, submission deadline to HUD deadline: no later than **August 26, 2026**.
- HUD anticipated award announcement date: December 1, 2026.

Eligible Applicants:

- Nonprofit with 501(c) 3 status with the IRS (other than institutions of higher education);
- State, county, city, and township government;
- Special district governments;
- Federally recognized tribal governments and tribal organizations;
- Public housing agencies and Indian housing authorities; and
- Faith-based organizations may apply on the same basis as any other organization, subject to the requirements in 24 CFR 5.109.

Eligible Project Types:

- Permanent Support Housing (PSH)
- Rapid Re-housing (RRH)
- Joint TH-RRH (renewals only; will not fund new TH-RRH projects)
- Transitional Housing (TH)
- Supportive Services Only (SSO) Projects
- HMIS (only available to the HMIS Lead)
- YHDP renewals and replacement projects
- Projects dedicated to serving victims of Domestic Violence
- Safe Haven (renewal only)

All projects must align with HUD priorities and meet eligibility and quality threshold requirements as established in NOFO.
